ST GEORGES BASIN AND VINCENTIA GOLF CLUBS - CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- The relative Match Committee oversees all competition play on the courses and reserves the right to alter the programme at any time.
- All play is governed by Rules of Golf in conjunction with Local Rules. If a competitor becomes aware of a breach of "Rules of Golf" by another competitor, it should be taken up with that player's marker and/or the player at the time it occurs. If the breach is not satisfactorily resolved at that time it may be referred to the Match Committee in writing for resolution, prior to close of day's competition.
- Lowest Handicap Member of each group is responsible for pace of play.
- Use of bad language is unacceptable.
- Only members of The Country Club Golf Clubs St Georges Basin or Vincentia are eligible to win Major Trophies and Monthly Medals, except Basin Open and Vincentia Open Tournaments which are open to accredited visiting golfers. Eligibility to win Club Championships and "major Club events" includes participation in at least five (5) singles competitions at either The Country Club St Georges Basin or Vincentia inside 12 months prior to event.
- Visitors must produce proof of current membership of another club and their Golflink card before being allowed to play. Visiting Veteran golfers should produce evidence of current membership of Veteran's Association.
- Members nominating to play in any Match play Competition should be prepared to fulfil their commitment for duration of competition.
- Players should not approach any committee members during play with hearsay or problems, as they also like to play & enjoy their game of golf.
- Players should adopt and maintain a reasonable standard of dress, in line with policy set down by The Country Club.
- Players should report to the Pro-shop at least 15 minutes prior to their starting time. Members who have placed their name on the Booking Sheet and find they cannot play or alter their tee time online must inform the Pro-shop as soon as possible.

Greens Staff always have right of way on the golf course.

GOLF COMPETITIONS AND HOW THEY ARE PLAYED

These notes are only intended to help in the general concept of how various competitions are played. They must be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf.

The Match Committee shall lay down the conditions under which a competition is to be played.

STROKE

The score at each Hole is entered on the scorecard, totalled and the player's full handicap deducted. The player with the least strokes wins.

MATCHPLAY

This type of competition is played Hole by Hole with the match winner being the player having won the most Holes.

PAR

When a player is beaten by par, the ball shall be picked up. This helps speed up play. After entering strokes taken on card, result is marked in column provided with a "+"sign for a win, an "O" for a half and "-"for a loss. At the end of the round plus and minus signs are added and subtracted and nett result written in as so many "Up", "Down", or "Square".

A player is allowed his full stroke handicap and strokes are taken at Holes indicated on the card. Where handicap is 18 or more, 2 strokes will be allowed on some Holes. These strokes are to be taken where indicated by index on card.

<u>STABLEFORD</u>

Players should take strokes at Holes (as in a par competition) using full handicap indicated by index and score points based on nett result at each Hole. At end of the round, points scored are added and player having highest number of points is the winner. In scoring, players get 2 points for net par, 1 point for net bogie, 3 points for net birdie & 4 points for net eagle. No points are scored for net double bogie or worse.

FOUR BALL BEST BALL Vs STABLEFORD

Scored like Stableford, except that better ball of partnership is credited with points at each hole. In a Par event, better ball is credited with plus or square.

FOURSOMES

Two play as partners and use one ball. The partners strike off alternately from tees and thereafter strike the ball alternately during the play of each Hole. Scoring is done as for a stroke round and the total is subject to a deduction of half the player's aggregate handicaps.

NOTE: If either player incurs a penalty stroke it does not alter the rotation of play.

CANADIAN FOURSOMES

Played as above except that both players play tee shots at every Hole and afterwards continue with whichever ball they nominate, the partner hitting the selected ball. Scoring is done as for a stroke round and the total is subject to a deduction of 3/8 of the player's aggregate handicaps.

AMERICAN FOURSOMES

Both players play tee shots at each Hole, and then play a second stroke with their partner's ball. One ball is then selected and play proceeds as in foursomes with the owner of the selected ball playing the third stroke. Handicap allowance is 3/8 of aggregate handicap.

<u>AMBROSE</u>

Teams comprise 2, 3 or 4 players. After each player plays a shot from the tee, they proceed to their ball. Team Captain selects the best positioned ball and places a mark on that spot. Each player places their ball within one club length of the mark, not nearer the hole and plays a shot. This procedure continues irrespective of whether selected ball is on fairway, within a penalty area or in rough. Play continues in this manner until green is reached. Note: If a selected ball is played within a bunker, penalty area or in the rough, then all balls must be played from the same conditions. When on the green, best ball is marked. Each player putts from within a card length of marked spot. Players must not putt out but continue to mark their ball until a ball is holed. During course of a round, each player must use a tee shot at least three (3) times with players initials marked on scorecard. Handicapping applicable is, for a team of four (4) one eighth of combined handicap, for a team of three (3) one sixth of combined handicap, for a team of two (2) one quarter of combined handicap.

Any other conditions of play may be decided by Match Committee on the day.
